WORKING WITH PDF FILES

Where links within this site refer to Adobe pdf files, the link has been indicated with [PDF]. To read and access the information contained in PDF files, you need to have software called Adobe Reader installed on your computer.

Adobe Reader is free of charge. If this is not already installed you can download Adobe Reader at: <http://www.adobe.com/products/acrobat/readstep2.html>.

PDF file size

Some PDF files are large and may not be easily accessible if you do not have broadband. For the size of each PDF file on this website, see:

Alternatively, if you mouse over the PDF link, a message will appear with the file size.

Opening PDFs

Once you have installed Adobe Reader, it should open whenever you click on a link to a PDF document. You can then read it on-line, print it on-line or save PDFs to your computer for later use.

Saving PDFs

PDF files can be saved to your computer and then opened and printed whenever you wish. To save a PDF file while on-line, click the 'save' icon on the PDF menu bar, then click the 'back' button to return to this website.

Printing PDFs

To print a PDF file while on-line, click the 'print' icon on the PDF menu bar, then click the 'back' button to return to this website.

If you experience printing problems, you may need to change your print settings by selecting Page Scaling 'fit to printable area' in the Adobe print dialog box which appears when you click the Adobe 'print' icon.

You may also have to ensure that the 'auto rotate and centre' check box is selected.
